

Seasons For Growth

Change and loss at any time can be challenging. We recognise that when changes occur in families through separation, divorce, bereavement or natural disaster events, children benefit from learning how to make sense of these changes. To support our children at Corpus Christi, we are offering an evidence-based education program called Seasons for Growth. The Seasons for Growth program is run in small groups. This is not a counselling service but rather a beneficial program where children learn to explore important ideas such as change is a part of life, naming and caring for feelings, problem-solving, making good choices and developing support networks. The children will attend the weekly sessions of 40–45 minutes for 8 weeks with Mrs Siva who has facilitated this course in previous years. She has undertaken training to be a Seasons for Growth Companion and is looking forward to implementing a program that involves child appropriate engaging sessions that use music, books, games and craft activities to explore the core concepts.

Stage 3- December 4th and Stage 2 December 6th


All students in each stage will be participating in the Netball Interschool day against other schools. We are needing 5 parents for each stage to help out as Team managers.


